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ACS Lifestyle Statement

Albany Christian School is a religious, non-profit organization representing Jesus Christ throughout the evangelical community worldwide and as such, Albany Christian School requires its employees to be born-again Christians, living their lives as Christian role models (Rom. 10:9-10; I Tim. 4:12; Luke 6:40).

Employees will conduct themselves in a way that will not raise questions regarding their Christian testimonies. A Christian lifestyle should reflect the biblical perspective of integrity and appropriate personal and family relationships, business conduct and moral behavior. An employee is expected to demonstrate a teachable spirit, an ability to share love for others, a willingness to live contentedly under authority and a commitment to follow the Matthew 18 principle when an issue arises with fellow employees or management.

The Albany Christian School Statement of Faith expects employees to maintain a lifestyle based on biblical standards of moral conduct. Moral misconduct, which violates the bona fide occupational qualification for employees to be Christian role models, includes, but is not limited to, promiscuity, homosexual behavior and/or sexual orientation, bisexuality, polygamy, transgender identity, or any other violation of the unique roles of male and female. (Exodus 20:14; Leviticus 18:7–23; 20:10–21; Deuteronomy 5:18; Matthew 5:27–28; 15:19; Romans 1:21-27; 1 Corinthians 6:9-20).

Albany Christian School believes that the term "marriage" has only one meaning: the uniting of one man (male gender at birth) and one woman (female gender at birth) in a single, exclusive covenant union, as delineated in Scripture. (Gen 2:18-25) and that God intends sexual intimacy to occur only between a man and a woman who are married to each other and that God has commanded that no intimate sexual activity is engaged in outside of marriage between a man and a woman. (Genesis 1:27–28; 2:21–24, Matthew 19:4–9; Mark 10:5–9; Ephesians 5:22–33).

That to preserve Albany Christian School's function and integrity its employees must be born-again Christians, living their lives as Christian role models (Rom. 10:9-10; I Tim. 4:12), maintaining a lifestyle based on biblical standards of conduct. Failure to do so may result in a reprimand or, in some cases, dismissal from employment. It is the goal of Albany Christian School that each employee will have a lifestyle where "...He might have the pre-eminence." Col. 1:18.

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ACS Code of Conduct

Willamette Community Church and its ministry, Albany Christian School, is a biblically based ministry. Our employees are to be biblical role models to the children and parents whom they serve. Therefore, as a ministry employee of Willamette Community Church and Albany Christian School, I agree:

To perform this work of ministry as for God Himself (Col. 3:23) and in submission to the authority of His word, the Bible.

To be supportive of Willamette Community Church/Albany Christian School, its philosophy, ministries, and leadership.

To manifest by precept and example the highest Christian virtue and personal decorum, serving as a Christian role model (I Timothy 4:12) both in and out of school to pupils (Luke 6:40), and as an example to parents and fellow staff members in judgment, dignity, respect, and Christian living. This includes, but is not limited to, refraining from such activities as the use of illicit drugs, and the use of vulgar and profane language (Col. 3:17, Titus 2:7-8, I Thess. 5:18, 21-23, and James 3:17-18); and being exemplary in the area of alcoholic beverages, consistent with the principles of Eph. 5:18, Rom. 14-15, and I Tim. 4:12

To follow the Bible's standards for sexual behavior. All sexual activity is to be within the bonds of the marriage commitment. (Marriage is defined as heterosexual union officially recognized and certified by the state or country in which the marriage was performed.) Deviation from Scriptural standards is grounds for termination (Romans 12:1-2; I Cor. 6:9-20; Eph. 4:1-11, 5:3-5; I Thess. 4:3-8; I Tim. 4:12; II Tim. 2:19-22; I Pet. 1:15-16, 2:15-17; I John 3:1-3).

To maintain an exemplary relationship with Willamette Community Church or another Bible-believing local church. This includes regular attendance, regular service, and an annual recommendation from his/her pastor (Hebrews 10:25; 2 Cor. 9:7; Eph 4:14-16).

To follow the biblical pattern of Matthew 18:15-17 and Galatians 6:1 and always give a good report. All differences are to be resolved by utilizing biblical principles. Internal church/school matters will not be discussed outside the staff or ACS School Board. Student/parent counseling matters will be kept confidential (Titus 3:2 and Gal. 5:15).

If at any time, I cannot support the aforementioned standards, I will remove myself from employment at Albany Christian School.

ACS Ministry of Teaching Policy

Christian Teachers are called by God to help educate students in academic, social, physical, and spiritual disciplines. The Christian teacher models him/herself after Jesus, the Savior, who was the master teacher. The primary method that Jesus chose to reach people with his message was teaching. He gathered his disciples and others around him and taught with such conviction and truth that the "many who heard him were astonished, saying, 'Where did this man get all this? What is the wisdom given to him? What mighty works are wrought by his hand!'" (Mark 6:2). His apostles, likewise, were teachers and gave witness "with great power" through their words and deeds, and "gave their testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus..." (Acts 4:33).

The Ministry of Teaching obligates the teacher to teach from the perspective that the order and discipline of mathematics or physics reveals the incalculable, consistent and orderly-structured mind of an ingenious God. It obligates one not only to simply instruct in geography and history, but to help students construct a biblical worldview by teachers teaching from the perspective that God created the known and unknown vastness of the universe; our world, its mountains, seas, rivers, deserts, forests, plains, and all the creatures that inhabit them. The Christian teacher teaches from the perspective that all human discoveries, empires, conflicts, and all social movements are measured by the divinely ordained order of a foreknowing, purposeful and design-oriented God.

The Ministry of Teaching also obligates the teacher to teach from the perspective that the magnificent design and unequivocal order of the universe and the dynamics of the interconnectivity of all creation is clear evidence of an incredibly Intelligent Designer of the universe.

Not only is the Christian teacher obligated to help students acquire skill in spelling, reading, grammar, and writing, but they are also obligate to help students understand that human language and culture is originally God designed and engineered as the primary means to understanding who He is, and is the primary mode by which students might explore the wonders of poetry and narrative and sacred Scripture itself—all of which indirectly or directly disclose salvation history.

Regardless of the subject, Christian teachers serve their students by teaching from a biblical perspective for the purpose of helping them grow to spiritual maturity, following the apostle Paul's admonition:

Finally, brethren, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is gracious, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. What you have learned and received and heard and seen in me, do: and the God of peace will be with you. (Phil 4:8-9)

As stated above, the goal of teaching is not simply the dissemination of information, but rather the transformation of one's worldview and character, which, in turn, influences others toward transformation.

Jesus himself confirmed this saying;

In the same way, (as a light is exposed to the word to see) let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven. (Matthew 5:16)

Paul more pointedly says to his protégé Timothy,

"Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity." (1timothy 4:12)

Christian Teachers must be ever mindful that they instruct not only through rational explanation of formal subject material, but even more powerfully through word, deed, example, and shared experience. Simply put, Christian Teachers teach by modeling the biblical principles as they are faithfully lived out in everyday experiences. This is why all Christian Teachers, even before their first meeting with students, must subscribe to the school's Statement of Faith. This is why Christian Teacher are required to live out a biblically based godly lifestyle, both at school and away for the world to witness. Christian Teachers must teach truth and avoid falsehood.

Paul encourages this very concept;

"Therefore, putting away falsehood, let everyone speak the truth with his neighbor, for we are members one of another. ... Let no evil talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for edifying, as fits the occasion, that it may impart grace to those who hear" (Ephesians 4:25, 29).

The Ministry of Teaching requires teachers to serve their students by providing them with faith experiences. They lead youth in confession, repentance, obedience, forgiveness, serving, prayer, praise, and demonstrating mercy.

Paul urged Christians to...

"Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander to be put away from you, with all malice, and be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you" (Ephesians 4:31-32).

Christian Teachers also model the Christian life by being active in their own church community and by serving as an intermediary assisting their students in becoming active in their respective church communities so that those students might be further nurtured in faith with their friends and family around them.
