



# Kindergarten Learning Objectives

We have 4 core subjects in Kindergarten at Albany Christian School. Reading, Math, Writing and Bible are our daily focus as we strive to reach the following goals:

## Reading

- Read all letters of the alphabet, capital and lowercase
- Read the phonetic sound of each letter
- Blend sounds together, in two, three-and four-letter combinations
- Develop phonemic awareness. This is an auditory skill that includes manipulating the sounds in spoken words.
- Read the difference between long and short vowel sounds
- Memorize 10 sight words, number words and color words
- Read basic sentences and answer comprehension questions to clarify meaning
- Understand the following punctuation: period, exclamation point, question mark, comma, apostrophes

## Math

- Count to 100 by 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's,
- Recognize number families and numbers to 100
- Manipulate numbers (# that comes before and after)
- Ordinal Numbers (1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> etc.)
- Number Words
- Addition, single digit
- Subtraction, single digit
- Graphing
- Counting Money
- Telling Time
- Introduction to Measuring

## Writing

- Write all letters of the alphabet, capital and lowercase in traditional manuscript
- Write numbers 0-9 and combinations to 100
- Be able to write and illustrate a sentence
- Use appropriate punctuation to clarify sentence meaning
- Write letter sounds and letter blends as dictated

## Bible

- Know that the Bible is the inspired word of God
- Father, Son and Holy Spirit
- Old Testament and New Testament
- Prayer is talking to God
- Memorize monthly Bible verse
- Understand definition of monthly character quality
- Learn that God is loving, caring, and trustworthy
